Legislative history

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Consent to Medical Treatment and Palliative Care Regulations 1996*.

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

#### 3—Interpretation

In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—

the Act means the Consent to Medical Treatment and Palliative Care Act 1995.

#### 4—Fees

The fee for making an application to the Registrar under section 14(3) of the Act to have a treatment direction or a medical power of attorney registered in the register established under that section is \$55.
