Legislative history

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Environment, Resources and Development Court Regulations 1993*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 15 January 1994.

3—Interpretation

In these regulations—

the Act means the Environment, Resources and Development Act 1993.

4—Fees

- (1) The fees set out in the Schedule are payable to the Court in relation to proceedings before the Court, other than criminal proceedings.
- (2) The fees that are payable in relation to criminal proceedings before the Court will be the fees that are from time to time set for the purposes of proceedings in the Criminal Division of the Magistrates Court under the *Magistrates Court (Fees)**Regulations 1992.

5—Interest rate

For the purposes of section 40(1) of the Act, the prescribed rate of interest is 10 per cent per annum.
