The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Parliamentary Remuneration (Basic Salary) Amendment Act 2012.*

2—Commencement

This Act will come into operation on 1 July 2012.

3—Amendment provisions

In this Act, a provision under a heading referring to the amendment of a specified Act amends the Act so specified.

Part 2—Amendment of Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1990

4—Amendment of section 3—Interpretation

Section 3, definition of *basic salary*—delete the definition and substitute:

basic salary means annual salary at a rate equal to \$42 000 less than the rate from time to time of Commonwealth basic salary;
