National Parks and Wildlife (Searcy Bay Conservation Park) Proclamation 2012

under section 30(1) of the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972

1—Short title

This proclamation may be cited as the *National Parks and Wildlife (Searcy Bay Conservation Park) Proclamation 2012.*

2—Commencement

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

3—Constitution of Searcy Bay Conservation Park

The following Crown land is constituted as a conservation park and assigned the name *Searcy Bay Conservation Park*:

Sections 101 and 102, Hundred of Wrenfordsley, County of Robinson;

Allotments 26, 27 and 28 of Deposited Plan 41664, Hundred of Wrenfordsley, County of Robinson.
