ORDINANCE enacted by the Governor of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

For the Further Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-six.

[2nd September, 1845.].

WHEREAS by the Acts or Ordinances of this Province, relative Preamble. to the Customs and Trade, and other Acts or Ordinances of this Province, certain duties, fines, and other moneys are or may be imposed, levied, and collected, to be paid to the Colonial Treasurer, on behalf of Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, for the public uses of the Province, and support of the Government thereof:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Governor of South Australia, further appropriawith the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, 1846. that out of the said duties, and the produce of all or any other the public revenue of the Province, not otherwise by law specially provided for, which from time to time hath accrued, or may accrue or become payable during the present year one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, or which shall have been otherwise unappropriated or unprovided for by law at the commencement of the

year, there shall or may be further issued and applied, over and above all other sums heretofore appropriated for the services of the year, in the manner hereinaster provided, for the several purposes hereinaster mentioned, any sum or sums of money not exceeding in amount respectively the several sums of money hereinaster specified; that is to say—

Grant in aid of Christian Religion and Education.

II. And with respect to the sum of One thousand one hundred and ten pounds and ten shillings to be applied in aid of the purposes of the Christian Religion or Education: BE IT ENACTED, that the same shall be divided amongst the different denominations of professing Christians in proportion to the respective numbers of their population according to the census returns; and shall be paid in proportionate sums to the Office bearers of every such denomination having charge of funds or other similar matters of a secular nature, according to the constitution and usages of such denomination; or, if there shall be no such Office-bearers known, or applicable to the case, then to such Trustees as shall be appointed by, or on behalf of any such denomination, in manner to be directed by the Governor, by Proclamation published in the South Australian Government Gazette: Upon trust, that the said Trustees shall duly apply the moneys so paid, in promoting Religion or Education, as they may deem most just and beneficial, having regard the wants particular localities; and on condition, of that the said Trustees shall, on or before the thirty-first day of March next, report to the Governor full and true statements and accounts of the due outlay of the moneys; such statements and accounts to be by the Governor laid before the Legislative Council as soon as may be after the then next assembling thereof.

Jewish Persuasion.

III. And with respect to the sum of two pounds eighteen shillings to be applied for the use of the Jewish Persuasion: Be in Enacted, that the same shall be paid to such Trustees as may be appointed by or on behalf of the said Persuasion, in such manner as may be directed by the Governor by Proclamation published as aforesaid: Upon trust, that the said Trustees shall duly apply the moneys so paid, in promoting Religion or Education, as they may deem most just and beneficial, having regard to the wants of particular localities; and on condition, that the said Trustees shall, on or before the thirty-first day of March next, report to the Governor full and true statements and accounts of the due outlay of the moneys, such statements and accounts to be by the Governor laid before the Legislative Council as soon as may be after the then next assembling thereof.

Treasurer to pay on order of the Governor, and discharged by receipt of the parties.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay from time to time, any sum or sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing, signed by him, from time to time direct; and the said Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly

accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sum shall have been so paid, shall be to him a full discharge for the sum or sums for which the same receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.
