# GEORGII V REGIS.

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## No. 1076.

An Act to authorise the construction of certain Waterworks to further increase the Water Supply of the City of Adelaide and other places suburban or adjacent thereto.

*[Assented to, October 2nd, 1912.]*

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "The Millbrook Waterworks Act, 1912." Short title.

**2.** This Act is incorporated with "The Waterworks Act, 1882," and all Acts incorporated with that Act except sections 110, 114, 115, 116, 117, and 118 of "The Lands Clauses Consolidation Act." Acts incorporated. No. 269 of 1882. No. 6 of 1847.

**3.** The Commissioner of Waterworks may, out of any moneys voted by Parliament for the purpose, construct and maintain, for the further water supply of the City of Adelaide and other places suburban or adjacent thereto, the waterworks known as the Millbrook Reservoir Water Scheme, and all other works which from time to time may be found to be necessary in connection therewith, within the limits of deviation shown on the plan deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, marked "Millbrook Reservoir Water Scheme," signed "Charles A. Bayer, Hydraulic Engineer," and dated the twenty-first day of August, nineteen hundred and twelve; and also construct and maintain such works and do such things as Commissioner of Waterworks may construct waterworks at Millbrook.
