An Act to amend the Act No. 399 of 1887, intituled  
“An Act to provide for the Payment of  
Members of Parliament.”

[*Assented to, December 7th, 1921.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,  
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as  
follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the “Payment of Members Act Amendment Act, 1921.” Short titles.

(2) The Act No. 399 of 1887, intituled “An Act to provide for the Payment of Members of Parliament,” the Act No. 476 of 1890, intituled “An Act to continue the Act to provide for the Payment of Members of Parliament,” and this Act, may be cited together as the “Payment of Members Acts, 1887 to 1921.”

2. (1) Section 1 of the said Act No. 399 of 1887 is amended by substituting for the words “Two Hundred Pounds” in the fifth line thereof the words “Four Hundred Pounds.” Amendment of 399, 1887, s. 1—  
Increase of salary of Members of Parliament.

(2) This section shall take effect from the first day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-one.
