An Act to amend The Adelaide Electric Supply Company's Acts, 1897 and 1922.

[Assented to, September 17th, 1931].

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Adelaide Electric Supply Company's Act, 1931". Short titles.

(2) The Adelaide Electric Supply Company's Acts, 1897 and 1922, and this Act may be cited together as "The Adelaide Electric Supply Company's Acts, 1897 to 1931".

(3) The South Australian Electric Light and Motive Power Company's Act, 1897, is hereinafter called the "principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1, and those Acts and this Act shall read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 27 of the principal Act is amended by adding after the words "by this Act" in the second line of paragraph (d) of subsection (1) thereof the words "or any regulation made under this Act." Amendment of principal Act, s. 27—
Enforcement of regulations.

4. The principal Act is amended by inserting therein after section 27 the following section:— New section 27A.—

27A. (1) The Governor may from time to time appoint a Committee consisting of two or more persons for the purpose of making Provisions for holding inquiries.

making an inquiry into the affairs of the Company and making recommendations on any matters submitted to the Committee by the Governor, and relevant to the affairs of the Company or its relations with consumers or the public. The Governor shall appoint one member of the Committee to be Chairman thereof.

(2) Such a Committee shall be deemed to be a Royal Commission within the meaning of that term as used in the Royal Commissions Act, 1917, and that Act shall *mutatis mutandis* apply in relation to all its members and proceedings.

(3) This section shall not limit the operation of paragraph (c) of section 27 of this Act.
