An Act to re-enact the Public Safety Preservation Act,
1930, for a certain period.

[Assented to, December 5th, 1931.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Safety Preservation Act, 1931". Short title.
2. This Act is incorporated with the Public Safety Preservation Act, 1930, and that Act and this Act shall read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. The provisions of the Public Safety Preservation Act, 1930, with the exception of the provision relating to the operation thereof, are hereby re-enacted, and shall remain in operation for a period of twelve months from the commencement of this Act. Re-enactment.
