An Act to amend the Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1927.

[Assented to, November 15th, 1932.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Workmen's Compensation Short titles. Act, 1932".
- (2) The Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1927, and this Act may be cited together as the "Workmen's Compensation Acts, 1911 to 1932".
- 2. Subparagraph (b) of paragraph (1) of the First Schedule to Amendment of the principal Act (as re-enacted by section 9 of the Workmen's Compensation Act Further Amendment Act, 1924), is amended by First Schedule inserting therein after the first proviso thereto the following Minimum additional proviso:—

Provided further that notwithstanding subdivision (ii.) of subparagraph (b) of this paragraph a workman of or above the age of twenty-one years who is a married man with or without children, or a widower having a child or children under the age of fourteen years totally or mainly dependent upon his earnings and whose average weekly earnings during such period as aforesaid did not exceed Thirty-five Shillings, shall receive during total incapacity the sum of Thirty-five Shillings per week, and a workman of or above the age of twenty-one years who is a single man or a widower not having a child or children under the age of fourteen years totally or mainly dependent on his earnings, and whose average weekly earnings during the period aforesaid did not exceed Twenty-five Shilling s, shall receive during total incapacity the sum of Twenty-five Shillings per week.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
