## GEORGII VI REGIS.

## No. 18 of 1942.

An Act to provide for the application of certain funds under the Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1925.

[Assented to 12th November, 1942.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Insolvent Act Amendment Act, 1942".
- (2) The Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1925, and this Act may be cited together as the "Insolvent Acts, 1886 to 1942".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Power to pay over certain surplus funds to Treasurer.

3. If the Judge in Insolvency is at any time satisfied that any amount standing to the credit of the Official Receiver in the floating balance (as described in section 228 of The Insolvent Act, 1886) or carried in the account called the Unclaimed Dividend Fund (as provided by section 229 of that Act), is in excess of the sum which the Judge in Insolvency is of opinion is necessary for the purpose of meeting any claim on or other payment from the said floating balance or Unclaimed Dividend Fund, the Judge in Insolvency may, from time to time, and notwithstanding any provision of the Acts incorporated with this Act, direct that any such amount in excess be paid to the Treasurer for the public use of the State.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty I hereby assent to this Bill.
