An Act to amend the Abattoirs Act, 1911-1947.

[Assented to 30th November, 1950.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Abattoirs Act Amendment Act, 1950".

(2) The Abattoirs Act, 1911-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Abattoirs Act, 1911-1950".

(3) The Abattoirs Act, 1911-1947, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 46 of the principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :—

(3) If at any time any such council is of opinion that the money provided to be expended pursuant to the arrangements made and approved by the Minister under section 13 of this Act and authorized to be borrowed by subsection (2) of this section is insufficient for the purpose, the council may, from time to time, by notice published in the *Gazette*, and in a newspaper circulating in the municipality or district, as the case may be, of the council give notice that it is proposed by the council to borrow such additional amount as is stated in the notice for any purpose mentioned in subsection (1) of this section. Within one month of the last publication of the notice, the requisite number of ratepayers in the municipality

or district may, by writing under their hands delivered to the mayor or chairman or town or district clerk of the council, demand that the question whether or not the amount should be borrowed be submitted to a poll of the ratepayers of the municipality or district, as the case may be.

If such a demand is made, the question shall be submitted to a poll to be held in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1934-1949, and the provisions of that Act relating to the conduct of polls, including section 427a thereof, shall apply with respect to the poll.

If no such poll is demanded or if at such a poll the question is or is deemed to be carried, the council may, in accordance with subsection (2) of this section, borrow the amount stated in the notice, and the provisions of subsection (2) of this section shall apply accordingly.

In this subsection the term "requisite number of ratepayers" shall have the meaning ascribed to that term by section 427 of the Local Government Act, 1934-1949.
