An Act to amend the Early Closing Act, 1926-1952.

[Assented to 17th December, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Early Closing Act Amendment Act, 1953".
- (2) The Early Closing Act, 1926-1952, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Early Closing Act, 1926-1953".
- (3) The Early Closing Act, 1926-1952, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of second schedule of principal Act—Exempted goods.

- 3. The second schedule to the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out in the first and second lines of paragraph 1 thereof the words "in quantities not exceeding two ounces of either in any one purchase";
  - (b) by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:
    - 11. Tobacco, cigarettes and cigarette papers.

4. The fifth schedule to the principal Act is amended by amendment of fifth schedule of principal act is amended by striking out the words "tobacco", "cigarettes" and "cigarette of principal Act—papers" in the first line of paragraph 1 thereof.

Amendment of fifth schedule of principal Act—Goods deemed to be available.

Goods deemed to be exempted goods.
