An Act to amend the Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1956.

[Assented to 24th October, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Milk Short titles. Supply Act Amendment Act, 1957".
- (2) The Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1956, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1957".
- (3) The Metropolitan Milk Supply Act, 1946-1956, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. This Act shall commence on a day to be fixed by commence proclamation.
- 4. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of in the definition of "metropolitan area" the words "Food and Drugs Act, 1908-1943" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "regulations for the time being in force under this Act".

Enactment of s. 28a of principal Act—

1957.

5. The following section is enacted and inserted in the principal Act after section 28 thereof:—

The metropolitan area. 28a. The Governor, on the recommendation of the Board, may make regulations defining or indicating the area which shall, for the time being, constitute the metropolitan area for the purposes of this Act.
