## No. 19 of 1958.

An Act to amend the Second-Hand Dealers Act, 1919-1950.

[Assented to 23rd October, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Second-Hand Dealers short titles. Act Amendment Act, 1958".
- (2) The Second-Hand Dealers Act, 1919-1950, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Second-Hand Dealers Act, 1919-1958".
- (3) The Second-Hand Dealers Act, 1919-1950, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- 3. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out paragraph (b) and inserting the following paraof section 6 of principal Act. graph in lieu thereof:—

Application for licence.

(b) a certificate of character in the prescribed form signed by two reputable householders residing in the city, town, township or district wherein the applicant resides or wherein he proposes to carry on business.

Amendment of subsection (1) of section 21 of principal Act—
Marking of serial number on goods.

- 4. Subsection (1) of section 21 of the principal Act is amended by adding the following paragraph after paragraph (b):—
  - (c) shall mark all second-hand goods bought or received with a serial number corresponding to the serial number for such goods shown in the purchases book. Such serial number shall be clearly marked on all such goods at all times whilst they are in the possession of the licensee.
