An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1934-1957.

[Assented to 30th October, 1958.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act, 1958". Short titles.

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1957, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1934-1958".

(3) The Road Traffic Act, 1934-1957, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the definition of "driver" in subsection (1); and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsections :—

(3) Any reference in any provision of this Part to drivers or the driving of vehicles shall be deemed to include a reference to riders and the riding of vehicles unless the provision by its express terms indicates that it does not apply to such riders or riding.

(4) The driver of a vehicle by which a trailer is drawn shall for purposes of this Part be deemed to be the driver of the trailer.

Amendment of

4. Section 119 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the definition of "driver" in subsection (1); and

(b) by adding at the end thereof the following subsections :—

(4) Any reference in any provision of this Part to drivers or the driving of vehicles shall be deemed to include a reference to riders and the riding of vehicles unless the provision by its express terms indicates that it does not apply to such riders or riding.

(5) The driver of a vehicle by which a trailer is drawn shall for purposes of this Part be deemed to be the driver of the trailer.

Operation
of this Act.

5. The principal Act shall have effect as if the amendments made by this Act had been included in the principal Act at the time of the passing thereof.
