An Act to amend the Constitution Act, 1934-1961.

{ *Reserved 28th November, 1963.* }
 { *Royal Assent proclaimed 6th February, 1964.* }

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Act Amendment Act, 1963". Short titles.

(2) The Constitution Act, 1934-1961, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Constitution Act, 1934-1963".

(3) The Constitution Act, 1934-1961, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. (1) Section 73 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "five thousand" (twice occurring) therein and inserting in lieu thereof the words "seven thousand five hundred" in each case. Amendment of principal Act, s. 73.

(2) The rate of salary fixed by subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three.
