An Act to amend the Prisons Act, 1936-1965.

[Assented to 12th December, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Prisons Act Amendment Act, 1968". Short titles.

(2) The Prisons Act, 1936-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Prisons Act, 1936-1968".

(3) The Prisons Act, 1936-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "one half of his sentence including any remission of his sentence granted pursuant to this Act or any regulation made thereunder" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "one-third of his sentence". Amendment of principal Act, s. 42—
