An Act to amend the Road and Railway Transport Act,
1930-1964.

[Assented to 1st April, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof,
as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road and Railway Transport
Act Amendment Act, 1971".

(2) The Road and Railway Transport Act, 1930-1964, as amended
by this Act, may be cited as the "Road and Railway Transport Act,
1930-1971".

(3) The Road and Railway Transport Act, 1930-1964, is hereinafter
referred to as "the principal Act".
