An Act to amend the Impounding Act, 1920, as amended.

[Assented to 3rd October, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Impounding Act Amendment Act, 1974".
- (2) The Impounding Act, 1920-1973, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Impounding Act, 1920-1974".

Commencement. 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 15—

Owner may impound on his own land cattle trespessing on such land.

3. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) the passage "five miles" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "eight kilometres".

Amendment o principal Act, s. 26—

Poundkeeper may charge for service of notice.

- 4. Section 26 of the principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by striking out from paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the passage "one shilling" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "ten cents";
 - (b) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "one shilling per mile for every mile or part of a mile" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "ten cents for every kilometre or part of a kilometre";

and

- (c) by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "one shilling per mile for every mile or part of a mile" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "ten cents for every kilometre or part of a kilometre".
- 5. Section 46 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subprincipal Act,
 ection (3) the passage "five miles" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "five miles" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "five miles". section (3) the passage "five miles" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage Liability of "eight kilometres".
