An Act to amend the Health and Medical Services Act, 1949.

[Assented to 12th December, 1974]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Health and Medical Services Act Amendment Act, 1974".

(2) The Health and Medical Services Act, 1949, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Health and Medical Services Act, 1949-1974".

2. The Long Title of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "for the establishment of an Advisory Council on Health and Medical Services,".

Interpretation.

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the definitions of "appointed member", "the council", "the chairman" and "member".

Repeal of ss.
3-13 of
principal Act.

4. Sections 3 to 13 (both inclusive) of the principal Act are repealed.

5. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "Public Service Act, 1936-1949" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Public Service Act, 1967, as amended".
