An Act to amend the Libraries and Institutes Act, 1939-1976.

*[Assented to 5th May, 1977]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Libraries and Institutes Act Amendment Act, 1977".

Short titles.

(2) The Libraries and Institutes Act, 1939-1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Libraries and Institutes Act, 1939-1977".

2. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (5) the word "provide" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "promote and encourage the establishment or improvement of or provide for".
