## An Act to amend the Holidays Act, 1910-1975.

[Assented to 18 December 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Holidays Act Amendment Act, 1980".
- (2) The Holidays Act, 1910-1975, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Holidays Act, 1910-1980".

Amendment of s. 3— Days fixed as holidays. 2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph II the passage "any of the several days" and substituting the passage "the day".

Amendment of s. 5— Governor may substitute another day for day appointed.

- 3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after its present contents (now to be designated as subsection (1)) the following subsection:
  - (2) The Governor may by subsequent proclamation vary or revoke a proclamation made under this section.

Amendment of second schedule.

- 4. The second schedule to the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by inserting in Part I after the item:

The third Monday in May

the item:

The second Monday in June.;

and

(b) by striking out from Part III the item:

The Anniversary of the Birthday of His Majesty or of any of His successors.
